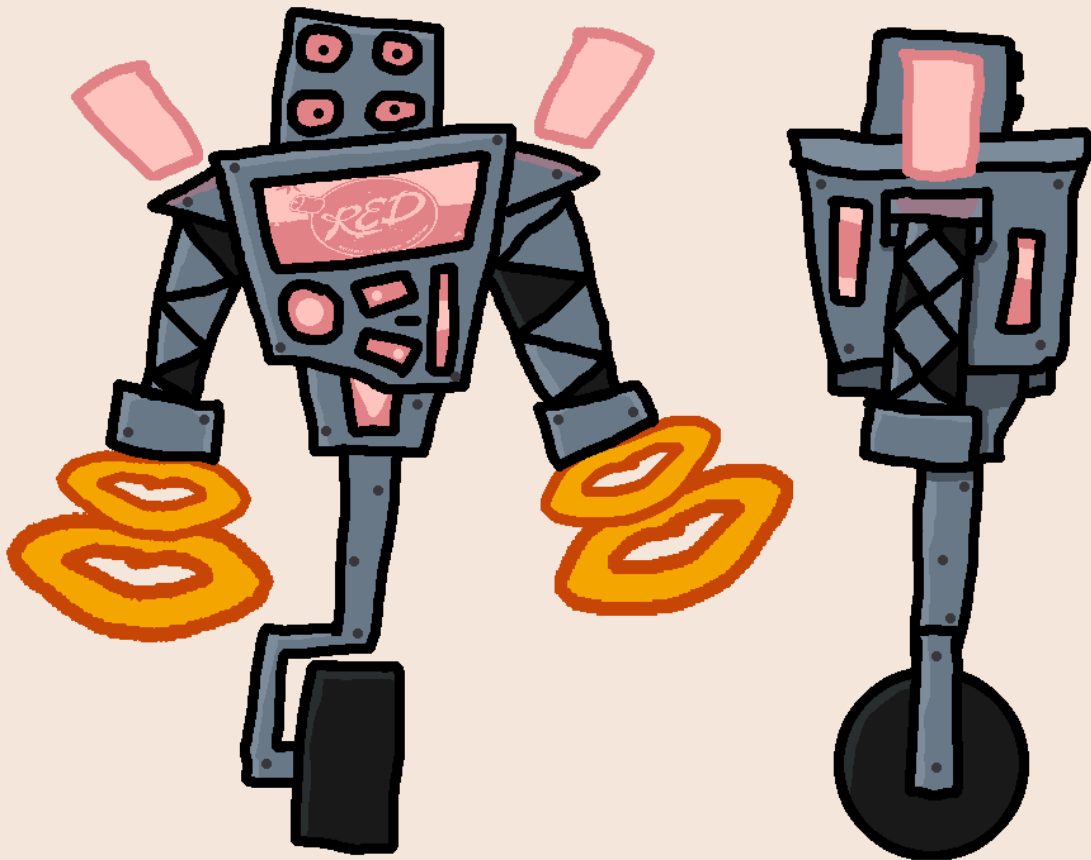


G.R.E.G. Manual

Machine Category: Objective / Enemy

G.R.E.G. is a very big robot, and the main objective of Robot Control. He has the ability to shoot fire rings (works like the Dragon's Fury), and shoot lasers from his eyes (like a crit boosted shooting star that has the visualized sightline some sniper rebalance mods have).

Robot Control

1. First, you have to capture the robot. This works kinda like koth_bagel, but instead of a big pillar, he's a big robot.



2. After the first team captures the point, the robot is activated! He is loyal to your side, and will try to kill the opposing team. The team who captured him (red) needs to defend him, and the team who didn't capture him (blue) needs to attack him.



3. He's not too powerful, with his attacks either being close range (Fire Rings) or heavily telegraphed (Laser Eyes), but he is very tanky at 6000 hp.



4. After the robot's HP is drained, it will heal itself back to full and switch sides. There is no way for its team to heal it, and it will drain health over time to avoid steamrolls.



5. The first team to keep the robot for a total of 5 minutes wins!



Specifics

HP Drain: (Total Players on defending team - Total Players on attacking team) X 10

Movement Speed: 69% *Same as Heavy moving backwards*

Fire Rings

Damage: 35

Afterburn Duration: 2.5 seconds, stacks on repeat hits

Clip Size: 5

Attack interval: 0.4 seconds

Reload Speed: 3 seconds

Reloads entire clip at once

Lasers

Start-up lag: 4 seconds

Damage: 500

Can Pierce

Ending lag: 2 seconds
